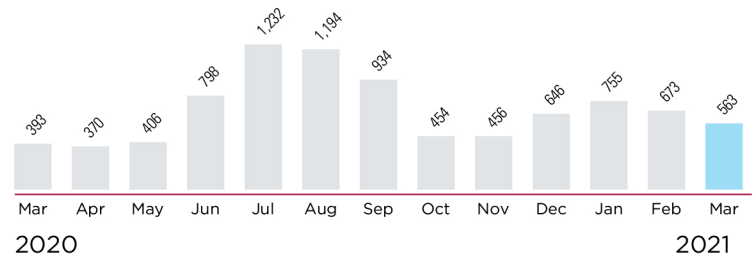

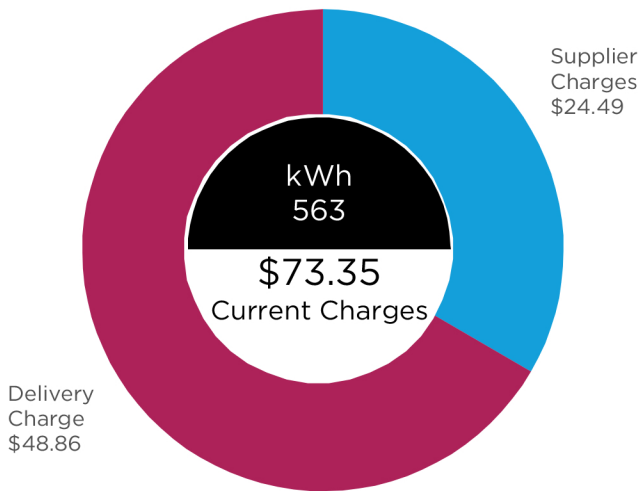

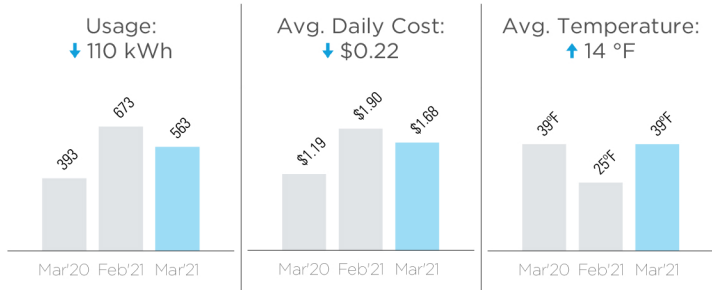

In Case No. 16-1852-EL-SSO, the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio approved the Ohio Power Company's Smart City rider. This rider allows the Company to recover costs associated with Smart City technologies. A residential customer will see a decrease of \$0.14 per month.

In Case No. 16-1852-EL-SSO, the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio approved adjustments to Ohio Power Company's gridSMART Phase 2 rider. This rider allows the Company to recover costs for grid modernization projects. A residential customer using 1,000 kWh per month will see an increase of \$0.75 per month.

In Case No. 12-2627-EL-RDR, the PUCO approved an adjustment to increase the Distribution Investment Rider, effective with this bill. This rider, which is adjusted quarterly, recovers capital costs associated with distribution infrastructure. A residential customer using 1,000 kWh per month will see a decrease of \$0.38 per month.

Do Not Tamper - Tampering with an energized electric meter can cause serious injury or death. If you suspect a problem with your meter, call the customer service number listed on your electric bill for assistance. In addition, meter tampering is illegal and can result in fines and/or imprisonment.

A smart meter is installed on your premises. **If service is disconnected due to non-payment, it will be remotely disconnected and no physical notice will be left at your service address.** On the day of disconnection, service will be shut off after 10 a.m.

As a participant in the AEP Ohio Customer Choice Program, your electric energy is being supplied by **AEP Energy Inc.** This bill reflects AEP Ohio charges for delivery of the electric and all electric energy supply charges AEP Ohio has received from your supplier as of the Billing Date shown on this bill.
